Document Title:	TEMPORARY RESPIRATORY OPD

#### PURPOSE:

- 1. To provide the necessary guidelines in the RMCI Outpatient Respiratory services.
- 2. To Identify cases to be catered to in the temporary OPD respiratory unit

LEVEL: DEM Physician, Resident on duty

### **DEFINITION OF TERMS:**

**Respiratory Cases** – They include conditions of the respiratory tract including the trachea, bronchi, bronchioles, alveoli, pleura, pleural cavity, and the nerves and muscles of respiration.

**Out Patient Department (OPD)** - is the part of a hospital designed for the treatment of people with health problems who visit the hospital for diagnosis or treatment, but do not at this time require admission.

**Epidemic** – a disease affecting many persons at the same time, and spreading from person to person in a locality where the disease is not prevalent. The World Health Organization (WHO) further specifies epidemic as disease occurring at the level of a region or community.

**Pandemic** – a disease an a significant portion of the population is affected. The WHO more specifically defines a pandemic as a worldwide spread of a new disease.

**Department of Health (DOH)** - is the executive department of the Government of the Philippines responsible for ensuring access to basic public health services by all Filipinos through the provision of quality health care and the regulation of all health services and products. It is the government's over-all technical authority on health.



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#### POLICY:

- 1. Temporary Respiratory OPD shall be activated only during infectious respiratory epidemic/pandemic.
- 2. Temporary Respiratory OPD shall be located in any designated area within hospital vicinity approved by the management.
- 3. Temporary Respiratory OPD shall comply with the DOH guidelines on outpatient operations.
- 4. Patients with pulmonary/respiratory symptoms are the only patients that can be catered at the Temporary Respiratory OPD.
- 5. Patients shall pass by the ER/OPD pre-triage area for pre-triage/ screening and shall present a note at the entrances issued by pre triage officer before being attended at the unit.
- 6. Temporary Respiratory OPD shall have a dedicated Cashier, Clerk, Medtech, Radtech, and CRO.
- 7. The Temporary Respiratory OPD opens daily from 9am to 9pm or on flexible time as approved by the management.



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#### PROCEDURE:

- 1. Patient who seeks OPD consultation is screened at the triage area
- 2. Nurse gives consultation note to patients and instructs patient to proceed to the OPD respiratory unit.
- 3. CRO verifies pre triage note and positions patient in the waiting area separating the adult, pedia and senior citizen and implements strict physical distancing.
- 4. CRO receives the pre triage note from patient and endorses this to the nurse on duty.
- 5. Nurse on duty ques the pre triage notes on a first come first served basis
- 6. Nurse on duty instructs the CRO to give patient the patient data form to fill in.
- 7. Nurse on duty calls patient name for consultation
- 8. CRO assists patient to consultation table
- Nurse on Duty receives accomplished patient data form, takes initial history, vital signs.
- 10. Nurse on duty gives the accomplished patients data form to the OPD clerk.
- 11. OPD clerk admits patient and verifies mode of payment.
- 12. Nurse on duty accomplishes patient consultation data form, secure consent and informs Doctor on duty.
- 13. Nurse on duty endorses patient to doctor as well as the accomplished patient consultation sheet for consultation.
- 14. Doctor on duty examines patient, gives initial diagnosis and orders diagnostic procedures, if needed
- Nurse on duty carries out doctors order, requests diagnostic procedures and medicines needed to bizbox.
- 16. Nurse instructs patient to wait at the waiting area for diagnostic procedure
  - 16.1 for laboratory, nurse informs standby laboratory personnel for blood extraction
  - 16.2 for Chest X ray, direct patient to OPX x ray near the MAB
- 17. Nurse on duty requests medication of patient to bizbox. Pharma MAB and informs MAB pharmacy to deliver medicines at the OPD respiratory unit




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- 18. Nurse on duty instructs the clerk to bill patient after all the procedure has been completed.
- 19. Nurse on duty instructs patient to settle account with the cashier inside the unit
- 20. Cashier informs the nurse that the patient account is settled.
- 21. Nurse on duty gives discharge instructions.
  - 21.1 to follow up official diagnostic result and bring it for the next visit
- 22. Nurse on duty discharges patient.



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### **FLOWCHART:**




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


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
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## **WORK INSTRUCTION:**

Clerks - Admits, bills, seeks HMO approval of patients

Cashier - Receives payments from patients

Medtech - Extracts blood from patients

Radtech - Does X-ray/ CT scan to patient

Triage Nurse- Screens patient prior to consult
