PURPOSE:

This document gives instruction on how to handle expired products and the products that are disqualified as "unfit for purpose" (laboratory reagents for COVID-19 RT-PCR).

SCOPE:

Applies to all Molecular Diagnostic Laboratory Personnel, Pathologists, Logistics Division Personnel of Dr. Pablo O. Torre Memorial Hospital (DPOTMH)

PERSON RESPONSIBLE:

End user, Logistics Division Personnel, Chief Finance Officer

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- 1 For the purpose of this standard operating procedure, the following terms are to be defined:
 - 1.1 *Expiration Date*. It refers to the date after which a consumable product such as reagents, and media used for COVID-19 RT-PCR which should not be used as it may be spoiled, damaged, or ineffective.
 - 1.2 *Shelf life*. It is the length of time that a reagent for COVID-19 RT-PCR may be stored without becoming unfit for use, or consumption.
 - 1.3 Disqualified products. It refers to reagents, media, and other supplies and consumables use for COVID-19 RT-PCR which are considered "unfit for purpose"/ "unfit for use".
- 2 The Section Head shall request COVID-19 RT-PCR reagents by making a Purchase Requisition duly signed by the Laboratory Manager, Ancillary Division Officer and routed to Budget and Cost Department for the verification of the remaining budget for the purchases.

- 3 Materials Management Department shall make the Purchase Orders for the reagents, supplies and other consumables needed for the COVID-19 RT-PCR testing.
- 4 The Department shall always verify the expiration date before using a product (Laboratory reagent, supplies, media and other consumables used for COVID-19 RT-PCR testing).
- 5 The Department shall not use reagent, supplies, and other consumables which are expired or disqualified.
- 6 The Department shall return the expired reagents to the Logistics Division.
- 7 The Department shall use a logbook to register all expired and disqualified products.
- 8 The Department shall record the reason for classifying the products as "out of use" in the logbook under "Reason" (e.g. expired products, product unfit for purpose).
- 9 The Section Head shall make an Incident Report of the served expired reagents, or nearing expiry reagents.
- The Department shall ensure that all expired or disqualified products are packed in a box marked "Do Not Use".
- If the reagents left are over the expiry date, the department ppersonnel shall destroy the remaining quantity as per the procedure mentioned in the SOP for "Disposal of waste generated".

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The Medical Technologist/Analyst informs the Section Head in case of the requirement of any laboratory reagent, supplies and other consumables for Covid-19 RT-PCR.
- 2. The Section Head makes a Purchase Requisition /Stock Requisition for the needed reagents, supplies and other consumables to the Materials Management Department after Purchase Requisition has been duly signed and routed.
- 3. The Materials Management Department makes the Purchase Orders to the different suppliers.
- 4. Once the supplies, reagents and other consumables have been delivered, the Warehouse In-Charge delivers it to the Molecular Biology Laboratory.
- On receipt of the reagents/supplies and other consumables for COVID-19 RT-PCR, the Section Head verifies it against the reagent, supplies, and other consumables requirement.
- The Medical Technologist/Analyst observes the physical condition/bottles, packs/boxes before receiving the reagents for Covid-19 RT-PCR testing.
- 7. After opening the reagent bottle, if abnormal observation is found in the physical appearance of reagent the Medical Technologist immediately informs the Procurement Section (Logistics Division).
- 8. The Medical Technologist/Analyst ensures the expiry date of a particular reagent before using it. Do not use any reagents after the expiry date.

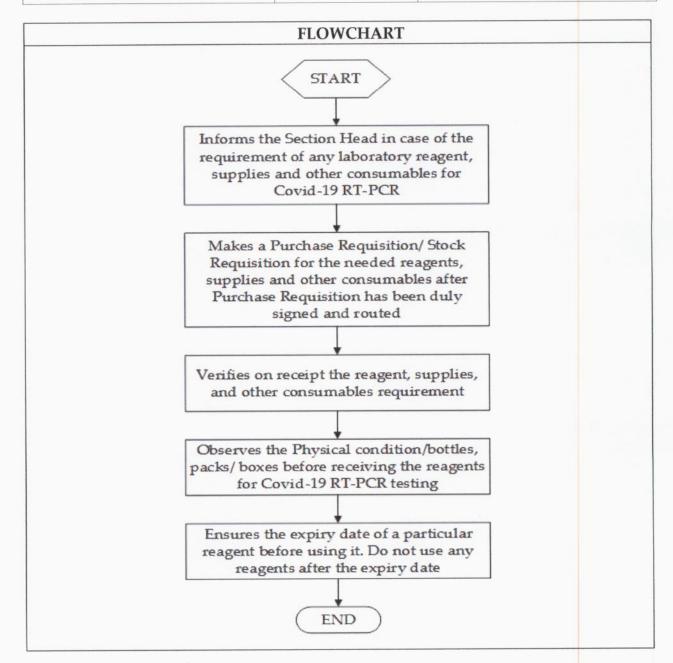
