KEY TASKS	PERSON RESPONSIBLE
1. Orients the mother/ immediate family about the safety protocol and security measures prior to admission of the neonate in the unit.	Staff Nurse
2. Provides an anklet to the baby for double identification with the same information in the wristlet provided by the delivery room personnel.	Staff Nurse
3. Follows Infection Prevention and Control practices before having direct contact with the neonates such as washing hands.	Visitors, family members, physicians, nurse and other personnel
4. Follows the process for "Claiming of the Baby During Discharge" to avoid incidence of abduction and handling of baby to the wrong family.	Staff Nurse

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
