## **PURPOSE:**

Internal Vaginal Examinations are done when a pregnant woman has:

- Symptoms of preterm labor.
- Uterine Contractions that may have changed the cervix. The cervix may be open and thin without strong or painful contractions.
- 3. Unusual pelvic pressure or back pain.
- 4. Vaginal bleeding
- 5. Ruptured amniotic membranes
- 6. To be checked for vaginal infection

### **OBJECTIVE:**

To provide a standardized procedure of safely performing Internal Examination to pregnant women.

# **RESPONSIBLE PERSON:**

Attending Physician OB-Gynecologist, Resident OB-Gynecologist, Registered Nurse, Midwife

# **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Internal examination should only be conducted by trained members of the health care team with clean hands covered by sterile gloves.
- 2. When the placenta is known to be overlapping or covering the cervix (placenta previa), internal exams are completely avoided. Disturbing the placenta can trigger bleeding.
- 3. Proper aseptic technique should be observed.

### **EQUIPMENT NEEDED:**

- · Sterile gloves
- Lubricating jelly


### PROCEDURE:

- 1. Nurse or midwife on duty gathers the materials at bedside.
- 2. Nurse or midwife on duty uses screen to provide privacy to the patient.
- 3. Nurse or midwife on duty maintains good lighting.
- 4. Any member of the health care team on duty explains procedure to the patient.
- 5. Nurse or midwife on duty lets the patient empty her bladder.
- 6. Nurse or midwife on duty places the patient in a dorsal recumbent position, drapes the patient properly and instructs the patient to relax while the Attending Physician or Resident on duty is doing the Internal Examination.
- 7. Members of the health care team observes universal precaution and does hand washing before the procedure is performed.
- 8. Nurse or midwife on duty assists the physician or resident on duty in the procedure by serving the gloves and KY jelly.
- 9. If the Resident on duty is the one who did the Internal Examination, they will inform the Attending Physician of the result.
- Nurse or Midwife on duty does aftercare and discards used gloves in the proper waste container.
- 11. Nurse or midwife on duty ensures that the patient's linen is tidy after the procedure.
- 12. All health care workers does hand washing after the procedure.
- 13. Nurse or midwife on duty documents the IE result on the labor room record.
- 14. Nurse or midwife lists materials used in the charge form. Ward clerk / attendant will encode charges via BizBox.





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
