

Document Title:	WASHING OF TUBE FEEDING BOTTLES

PROCEDURE:

- Wash hands well with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- 2. Separate all bottle parts.
- 3. Rinse bottle parts and any other feeding items by holding them under running water.
- 4. Wash the tube feeding bottle parts.
 - Place all items in the rack located in the designated sink. Do not wash directly in the sink because it may contain germs that could contaminate these items.
 - 4.2 Scrub items using a clean brush that is used to only clean the feeding items
- 5. Rinse by holding items under running hot water.
- 6. Place bottle parts in the dishwasher. Run the dishwasher using hot water and a heated drying cycle.
- 7. Wash hands with soap and water before removing and storing cleaned items.
 - If items are not completely dry, place them on rack to air dry before storing. Do not use a dish towel to rub or pat items dry because doing so may transfer germs to the items.
- 8. Place the tube feeding bottles in a clean place away from dust, dirt and insects.
- 9. Stored tube feeding bottles are now ready for use.
- 10. Repeat the same steps to process used feeding bottles returned from the station.



FLOWCHART:






