PURPOSE:

- 1. To ensure a safe and operational environment for patients and healthcare workers.
- 2. To provide a specific written procedure on termite control.

DEFINITIONS:

Termites - Sometimes incorrectly called "white ants", are a group of social insects usually classified at the taxonomic rank of order Isoptera. Termites are wood-eating insects that can damage building infrastructure, including hospitals. In this sense, "termites in a hospital" could refer to a pest control or structural integrity issue.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Facility Maintenance Assistant Manager, Contractors, Hemodialysis Personnel

POLICY:

- 1. The termite control chemicals or toxicants shall be able to immediately exterminate termites or create barriers to discourage the entry of subterranean pests and vermin in the hemodialysis unit.
- 2. Termite control operation shall be performed by the Contractor duly recognized by the Facility Maintenance and Engineering Department.
- 3. There shall be a regular or scheduled termite control as maitenance
- 4. The Contractor shall adhere to the strict guidelines for pesticide usage which are acceptable or recommended for patient safety.







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PROCEDURE (SOP):

- 1. The Contractor, before starting the procedure will sign-in to the Logbook of Termite Control provided by the Hemodialysis Unit for documentation.
- 2. The Contractor in coordination with Facility Maintenance (Engineering Department implements the scheduled termite control program.
- 3. After the termite control operation, the Hemodialysis Manager/Supervisor or his/her designee receives and signs the job order.
- 4. The Hemodialysis Manager/Supervisor or his/her designee gives back the signed job order to the Contractor.
- 5. Hemodialysis Personnel keeps record of service report for documentation purposes.
